

RECIPE FOR ITEM 24 (Chocolate Cake made by a male)

RICH CHOCOLATE CAKE

185g butter
2 teaspoons vanilla essence
1¾ cups castor sugar
3 eggs
2 cups self-raising flour
2/3 cup cocoa
1 cup water

Grease a deep 23cm round cake pan, line with paper; grease paper.

Combine butter, essence, sugar, eggs, sifted flour and cocoa and water in a large bowl, beat on low speed with electric mixer until ingredients are combined. Increase speed to medium, beat for about 3 minutes or until mixture is smooth and changed colour. Spread into prepared pan.

Bake in moderate oven for about 1½ hours.

MAKE SURE YOUR OVEN IS NOT TOO HOT!

Stand 5 minutes before turning on to wire rack to cool.

 Make sure when presenting Collections that your vase is large enough, and mark which side is the viewing side. Use a vase which is suitable to display your flowers, and do not overcrowd.
- Mixed can be one variety, but must consist of buds and open flowers.


