PIE EATING COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATION

- 1. Entries will be taken on the day
- 2. Event will be run as a Calcutta
- 3. The Committee will determine the percentage of the Calcutta Pool to be paid out
- 4. Prizes will include 1st, 2nd and 3rd for each age group and a prize package
- There will be two (2) age groups: Junior - 12yrs and under 18yrs Senior -18yrs and over
- 6. All competitors compete at their own risk
- 7. A Waiver Form must be completed by all entrants
- 8. The Committee reserves the right to add, delete or vary this schedule, and in all cases the Committee's decision will be final
- 9. Pies to be consumed will be meat
- 10. Beverages to be consumed either Milk or Lemonade Cordial
- Quantity to be consumed:-Junior – Two (2) pies and One (1) cup of milk or cordial Senior – Three (3) pies and One (1) cup of milk or cordial
- 12. The winner will be competitor who has consumed the set number of pies and drink for each group, in the fastest time

Competition Area:

Barriers will be erected to separate the competition area from spectators and marshals will be on hand to maintain this

Entries will be taken in the marshalling area by the chief steward

Entrants to remain in the marshalling area until requested to enter the competition area Tables will be in place for the pies and cordial to be place upon during the competition Entrants will remain behind the tables during the competition, until requested to leave First Aid engaged for the Show Days to be advised of commencement time of the competition

Food Handling and Safety:

The size of the pie will be that of an average meat pie purchased from a Bakery Pies to be stored in a Pie Warmer until required Temperature of the pies to be warm

Gloves to be used when handling the pies

Tongs to be on hand for removal of the pies from the Pie Warmer

Tables to be sanitized following each round of the competition

Milk to be stored in esky with ice

Cans of Cordial to be stored in an appropriate vessel

Bottles of Water to be on hand and stored in an appropriate vessel

Paper Plates to be provided for the pies to be placed on during each round of the competition

Small paper cups to be on hand

Paper Napkins to be provided for entrants use during and following each competition round Waste Bins to be on hand for disposal of pies and cordial cans after each competition round Spray Sanitizer and paper towel to be on hand
