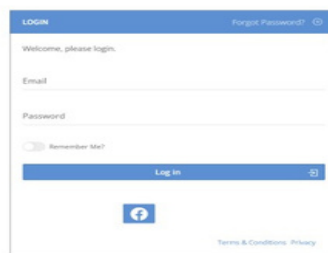
First time user

Do this for each entry
Once you have completed all entries move onto the following steps.
- Step 2** Print Form by clicking the Print Form button on the top right.
- Step 3** Print Tags by clicking the “Print Tags” button on the top right.
- Step 4** Once you have both your entry form and tags printed, cut out and attach your entry tags to each item ensuring the section and class is correct.
If you make a mistake, you can delete your entry from the list of entries by clicking “Delete”.
Note that any deleted entries may still be visible but have “Deleted” or “Del” next to them.

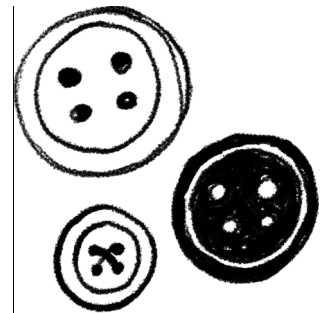
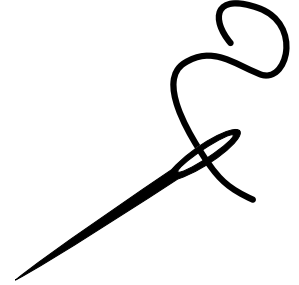

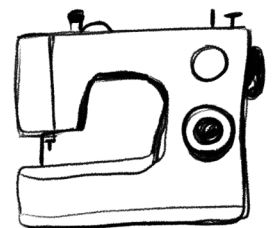

Rich Chocolate Cake Recipe

From Tin Eats

- ***Preparation:****
- Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan-forced).
- Grease and line a 20cm deep round cake pan with baking paper.
- ***Tip:**** Wet and wring out baking paper for better lining.
- ***Ingredients:****
- 1¾ cups plain flour
- ¾ cup cocoa powder
- 1½ tsp baking powder
- 1½ tsp bicarbonate of soda
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 tsp salt
- 2 eggs
- 1 cup milk
- ½ cup oil
- 2 tsp vanilla
- 1 cup boiling water
- ***Instructions:****
- 1. Sift flour, cocoa, baking powder, and soda into a bowl; whisk.
- 2. Add sugar and salt; whisk.
- 3. Mix in eggs, milk, oil, and vanilla until smooth.
- 4. Stir in boiling water (batter will be runny).
- 5. Pour into pan; bake 40-45 minutes.

Cool 10 minutes; transfer to a cloth-covered rack.

- Judging criteria will include presentation, appearance, texture, and taste (exhibits will be cut). Decorated cakes will be judged solely on appearance and will not be cut.

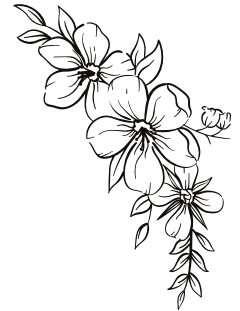

PRESENTATION OF ENTRIES

- All single stem exhibits must be displayed in containers provided by Section Stewards.
- For all other exhibits, using a vase will enhance their appearance, so be sure to select one that complements your flowers.
- Avoid removing the top leaves from your flowers, particularly roses and single flower exhibits, whenever possible.
- For Collections, it's preferable to showcase different varieties; however, if that's not feasible, aim for different colors at the very least. Ensure your vase for Collections is sufficiently large and clearly mark the viewing side. Choose a vase that highlights your flowers without overcrowding, and trim excess foliage.
- Mixed arrangements can include a single variety but must feature both buds and open flowers.
- Keep the size and weight of vessels, vases, and containers manageable for one person to move easily.
- The overall height, including the vessel, stem, and flowers, should not exceed 50 cm.

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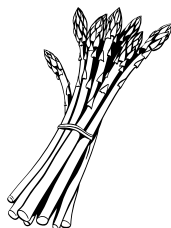

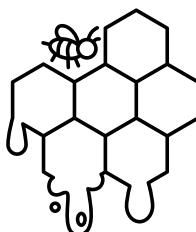

- A ribbon will be presented for the Most Successful Entry in this Section, and a Champion Ribbon will be awarded for the Best Entry, at the Judge's discretion.
- Prize money can be collected from the Secretary's Office at the Showground during the Show hours.

PRESENTATION OF ENTRIES

Jar contents must be at least one (1) cup and should completely fill the jar.

- Please refrain from using wax, paper, cling wrap, or similar materials for lids or covers.
- Ingredients must be clearly labeled on the jar, along with the date of preparation.
- Ensure that there is no advertising or producer identification on the label or jar. Remove any old labels from recycled jars.

The Judge will evaluate based on the presentation and appearance of both the contents and containers, and all exhibits will be tasted. Please inspect your entries for any issues such as mold, leaks, or rusty lids.

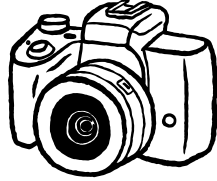

- Ensure you label the back of both your photo and the mounting card with your name. PLEASE DO NOT ADD ANY IDENTIFYING MARKS ON THE FRONT OF THE PHOTO OR MOUNTING CARD.
- Sculpture – limited to 500g of modeling clay.
- Paddle Pop Stick House – must be mounted on a board no larger than 25cm x 35cm.
